WHAT IS THE TERM OF THE LEVY?

The M & O Levy will be voted on yearly.



WHAT DOES THE LEVY DO?

Since the State does not fully fund essential programs, the M & O Levy will help play a major role in implementation of our Six Year Transportation Plan. These programs require anything from 5% to 13.5% matching funds which the City must be able to provide.



\$.50 PER \$1,000 OF TRUE AND ASSESSED VALUATION

EXAMPLE OF ASSESSED VALUES:

- \$400,000 Assessed Value = \$200/year for taxes
- \$350,000 Assessed Value = \$175/year for taxes
- \$250,000 Assessed Value = \$125/year for taxes
- \$100,000 Assessed Value = \$50/year for taxes

The M & O Levy must pass by 60% or more of votes cast.
