A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RESEARCH OF VACATING THE ALLEYWAY BETWEEN SECOND AND THIRD STREET/FILMORE AND MONROE BLOCK 34, LOTS 5 THRU 10 OF SCHANK & REEDS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ASOTIN CITY COUNCIL TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Asotin-Anatone School District has requested to vacate the alleyway between the bus garage, the agricultural shop and museum officially located between Second and Third Street/Filmore and Monroe Block 34, Lots 5 Thru 10 of Schank & Reeds Addition; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is asking the Asotin City Council Transportation Committee to research and set up a public hearing to go forward with the decision of vacating the alleyway; and

WHEREAS, the Asotin City Council Transportation Committee will set a public hearing for Friday, July 7, 2017 at 2:30pm at City Hall 121 Cleveland Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Asotin, The Asotin City Council Transportation Committee will set a date for discussion about the Asotin-Anatone School Districts request to vacate the alleyway between Second and Third Street/Filmore and Monroe Block 34, Lots 5 Thru 10 of Schank & Reeds Addition and set a date for a public hearing.
